AEA Director elected as CLASS President

AEA Director Sonia Gementiza was elected president of the Cavite Librarians Association, Inc. (CLASS) for 2009-2010 during its General Assembly held on Dec. 5 at the Audio Visual Room of the Imus Institute, Imus, Cavite. Gementiza will serve as president for two years, together with other elected officers namely: Concepcion Villanueva of Cavite Provincial Library, vice president; Jennifer Cruz of University of Perpetual help Rizal, secretary; Eugene Kamantigue of Imus Institute, treasurer; Esmeralda Vinzon of National College of Science and Techonology-Dasmariñas, auditor; Reden Cruzado of San Sebastian College-Recoletos, public relations officer. Gementiza assumed the CLASS presidency when Ma. Merconi Fermejo of Cavite State University-Cavite City vacated the post in April 2008. Gementiza formerly held the vice presidency post.

CLASS is the professional association for librarians and information professionals in Cavite and is a Chapter Member of the Philippine Librarians Association, Inc.–Southern Tagalog Librarians Region Council. The Association was founded in 1981 as Cavite Library Associations. The Association changed its name to Cavite Librarians Association, Inc. in 2005 before filing registration as a non-stock, non-profit corporation on May 19, 2006 at the Securities and Exchange Commission.

CLASS promotes Information Literacy

Recognizing the importance of information skills to the success of lifelong learning, employment and in daily interpersonal communication, the Cavite Librarians Association, Inc.(CLASS) organized a forum on Information Literacy (IL) at Imus Institute Audio Visual Room, Imus, Cavite on Dec. 5.

IL is defined by Trauth, Kahn, and Warden in their book *Information Literacy: An Introduction to Information System* as “the ability to identify, gain access to and manipulate, and effectively use information within the context of one’s personal and professional lives.” The UK’s Chartered Institute of Library and Information Professionals described IL as knowing when, why, where and how to evaluate and communicate information in an ethical manner. Jamie McKenzie, in his article “Winning with Information Literacy,” summarized IL into three words: Prospecting, Interpreting and Creating.

FL adviser and the president attend 34th YMCA Congress

Friends of the Library (FL) adviser and AEA Acquisition Librarian Rhodora Espiritu, along with FL President Angeline Dellomas and University Student Council (USC) Vice President Ailene Orong, USC Treasurer Edgeline Jovero, and USC Public Relations Officer Julie Pearl Merlin represented the University in the 34th YMCA National Congress of College Students and 14th YMCA National Campus Club Advisers' Seminar-Workshop held on Jan. 14-18 at Teachers' Camp, Baguio City.

The event gathered together a total of 350 delegates from 43 colleges and universities nationwide. Engr. Richard Peñaflor, a Congress alumnus and incumbent treasurer of the YMCA of Manila, inspired the delegates with the story of his life and the fruits of hardwork and determination to rise against poverty. Peñaflor told the delegates to never give up and pursue their studies. He said that challenges are forms of learning that God gives to people to improve themselves.

Another resource speaker, Isabela Governor Maria Gracia Padaca, challenged the delegates to be the saviors of the nations more than being its hope. She said that the youth can be more than the hope of the nation because they will be the one to decide where the Philippines will go. The award winning governor emphasized in her speech the vital role played by the youth in selecting the right leaders of the country in the coming 2010 election. "You are a cut among the rest, and so much more is expected from you," Padaca reminded the delegates.

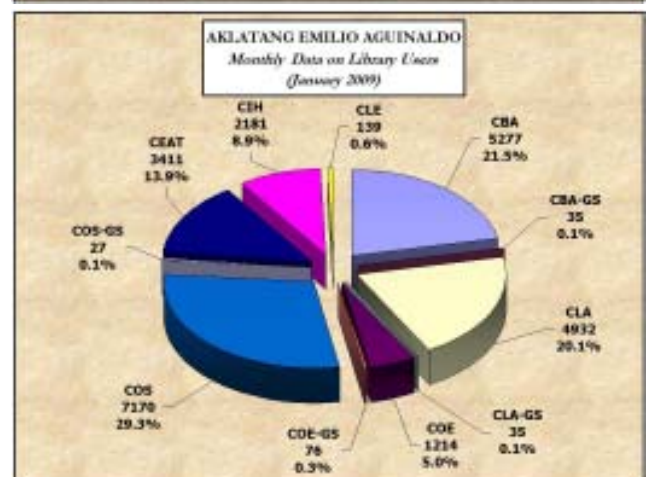
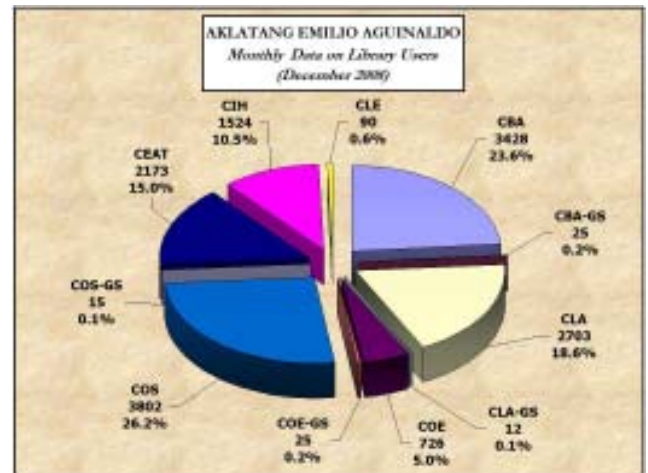
Meanwhile, Dr. Angelito Manalili of the University of the Philippines discussed the ways on how the socio-economic problems of the country could be solved.

The YMCA Congress also had an activity wherein the participants simulated the Congress of the Philippines, which taught the student leaders the basics of parliamentary procedures and provided them an overview on how a bill becomes a law.

COS still leads Dec-Jan stat on library users

Since June of this schoolyear, the College of Science (COS) continued to be AEA's number one user. For the months of December and January, COS has recorded a total of 10,972 student users.

The College of Business Administration maintains its rank as the second top library user with a total of 8,705 student users on both months. Meanwhile, the College of Liberal Arts remains the third top library user with 7,635. A total 39,020 or an average of 1,027 users per day has visited, used, and availed of the library facilities and services for the months of December and January.



On the books borrowed for overnight and home-use, students registered a total of 30,323 books or an average of 759 books per day. On the other hand, faculty and staff borrowed a total of 22,770 or 569 books per day. Books on social sciences, sciences, psychology, medicine, languages, and literature are the frequently borrowed books by the students and faculty members.

Prospecting is the ability to locate, sift, sort, and select right information. Interpreting is the capacity to translate the data and information into knowledge, insight, and understanding, while creating is the capability to transform these knowledge and insight into new ideas and concepts. IL helps empower people to seek, evaluate, use, and create information wisely and intelligently. It is a skill that can be learned and acquired by any individual who is willing to learn and relearn.

Retired DLSU Library Director and Archivist Fe Angela Versosa served as the forum's resource person. Versosa emphasized in her lecture the important role played by the librarians and information professionals in the creation and promotion of institutional information literacy program in coordination with the administration and faculty members.

"The librarian, as part of the academic community and as experts in information management, should assume the key role of facilitating information literacy," Versosa said. "She should actively contribute to the students' learning processes in their search to enhance or develop the skills, knowledge and values needed to become the lifelong learners", she continued.

RIS Book Review for the months of December'08 and January'09

Ramos, M.D. **The Aswang Complex in Philippine Folklore.**

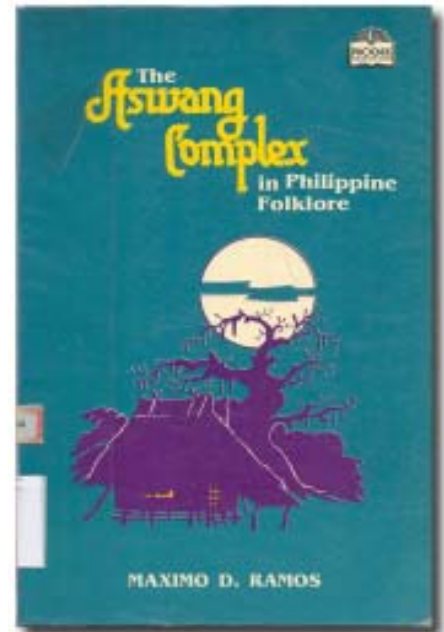
The book contains stories on *aswang* as they were encountered by different people from Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao. Each story confirms the existence of either man or woman known to have possessed mysterious traits peculiar to *aswang*. In contrast to the characters of lower mythology of the Western countries, *aswang* don't appear to be good, on the contrary, they are perceived to be evil causing misfortune, illnesses, and even deaths to people.

The stories narrated situations where the *aswang* moves to execute his/her plan of victimizing the target. The identity of the *aswang* is classified into the following: the blood-sucking vampire, the self-segmenting viscera sucker, the man-eating werewolf, the vindictive or evil-eye witch, and the carrion-eating ghoul. The *aswang* is always seen as fearsome and ugly with murderous action to match, and the action of the evil entity does not imply any values for emulation because it personifies evil; its extinction is always sought violently. The stories' tone was dark and frightening and could hardly be called entertaining.

F. Landa Jocano (former Department of Anthropology Chair of University of the Philippines-Diliman) commented that "the materials in this book as folklore can be regarded as ethnographic data in that they deal with one of the dominant aspects of Filipino folk culture. The *aswang* belief may be viewed as socially functional in many communities. Our field notes on the subject matter indicate that *aswang* tales are used by many people as a medium of social control." A mother who finds the tantrums of a little child unbearable may use the *aswang* belief as to pacify or discipline the latter. When the landowner wishes to protect his property from trespassers, all he has to do is to make it known that an *aswang* haunts the place. The *aswang* label is also effective in handling deviant behavior because once the label is set, deviants are either forced into conformity to what is an acceptable behavior or they will be deprived of their legitimate status in the community.

As the author contends several customs among Filipinos have stemmed-up as results of the *aswang* belief system. Careful examination of these practices may facilitate emergence of more positive result rather than intensifying vague ideas. In marrying somebody whose lineage is obscure, does one prevent himself from having a vampire in the family? Does knowing the person well before marriage intensifies other values other than safety from vampire's lineage? Will it be all right to fear people coming from Sorsogon and Tabaco, Albay as well as from Aklan and Capiz because of their reputation to our society as home of *aswangs*? Do we only safeguard our stares to other people because we fear to offend witches? Do we force ourselves to make unnecessary noises to ward off prospective visiting ghoul?

The readers are admonished to ponder on their manners of treating other people specially those who are close to them whom they gained trust and confidence. Are there instances when manipulation and deception are the motives behind one's action toward another just to ensure sympathy and approval? Do we silently observe people without their notice, their weaknesses for us to pounce on their defenselessness? Do we wish harm and misfortune for them because they have wronged us? Do we aspire for their subjugation for us to vindicate our cause? Positive affirmation of the stated inquiries would pose a serious consideration, though mythical, *aswang* is less dangerous to deal with! One does not become an *aswang* in ways the stories had mentioned but more so in becoming source of stress for others, inwardly draining their enthusiasm and inspiration for death to suck their potentials and quest for meaningful existence.



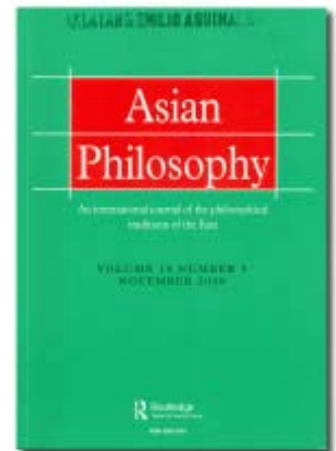

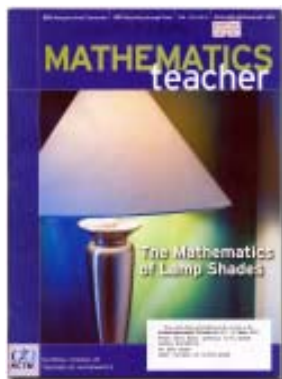


Harvard Educational Review. Cambridge, MA : Harvard Graduate School of Education.

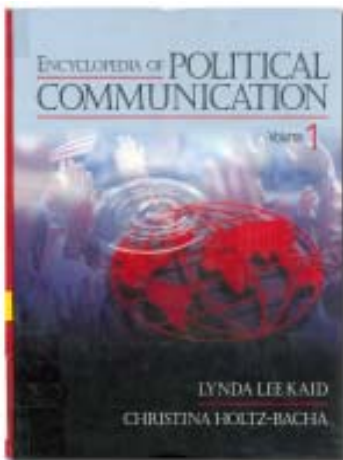

Encyclopedia of political communication. (2008). Los Angeles : Sage Publications

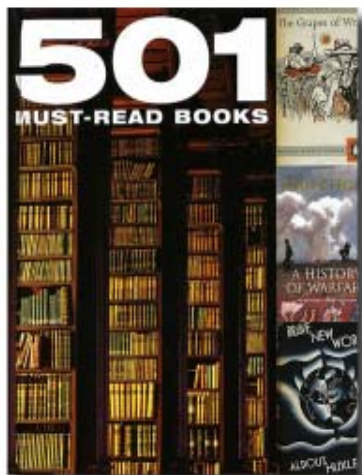
